Bylaws Article VI-Officers, Qualifications, Duties, Tenure, Vacancies, and Removal from Office

## 6.1, c. Tenure

Proposed by: Bylaws Committee
Rationale: During their terms as President and President-Elect, these officers should be focusing on the business of leading the National Association. Given the extend of the job duties of these positions, it is felt that these leadership roles should not hold any other officer positions or have voting privileges on a local board. The other positions on the National Board may serve on a local board if they so choose.

Proposed by: Bylaws Committee
Rationale: Proposing this amendment be added separately to address officer term of office if there is an open position on the board that the National President may fill with appointment. Serving only two (2) terms allows for other members to serve on the national board.

Next Steps: If approved by the board, the ballot to the membership would need to be sent out by April $20^{\text {th }}$ with 30 days to collect ballots to May $20^{\text {th }}$ to have it completed for Installation of the 2023-2024 Board of Directors.
